NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLAND directs staff to have the colored lighting on the Main Street bridge every day for at least two (2) hours immediately after dusk.

Council adjourned at 9:39 p.m.
