LEGISLATED PUBLIC HEARINGS PURSUANT TO THE PLANNING ACT

<u>17-57Z</u> A complete application has been made by JOHN PERRY on behalf of N SQUARE DEVELOPMENT GROUP LIMITED to rezone the lands at 699 Niagara Street (west side of Niagara Street, south of Woodlawn Road) from the existing R2 Single-Detached Dwelling - Second Density Zone to a Site Specific RM4 Zone. The purpose of the Amendment is to permit the construction of a 7 storey condominium building with 42 residential units, allow for a reduced front yard setback of 5.1 metres, whereas 9 metres is required; a reduced rear yard of 3.5 metres whereas 9 metres is required; side yard setback of 2.5 metres, whereas a minimum of 4.5 metres is required; and allow for 1 parking space per unit, whereas 1.5 spaces per unit is required. The Official Plan designation is HIGH DENSITY RESIDENTIAL. The lands are also the subject of an Application for Standard Condominium - File 26CD-14-17001, (File No. 2017-01).

JOHNS CONSULTING GROUP AND JACKIE LEE on behalf of DAO SHENG CHEN AND MIAO YAN CHEN to amend the City of Welland Official Plan and to rezone the lands at 16 Steel Street (Lots 232 and 233, Plan 933, Part Lots 230 and 231, Plan 933) from the existing RM3 - Multiple Dwelling - Third Density Zone - Exemption 12.8.5 and C3 - General Commercial Zone - Exemption 21.3.4 to a Site Specific MXR Zone. The purpose of the Amendment is to allow for two (2) residential units, a restaurant and a warehousing use; to exempt the property from providing an amenity area for the residential uses; and to exempt the property from Section 5.21 (e) of the Zoning By-law which would require the construction of a fence separating the required parking lot from any adjacent uses.
