WHEREAS the Region has increased the number of available beds to support homelessness in Welland by 8 beds from November 1, 2023 to April 30, 2024 which at 2 persons per room, would support approximately 50 individuals and that Welland Council received for information, and appreciates the Long Term plans as set out in Report CS-2023-26 on October 24, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Council has not had a report from the Homeless Working Group on the plans for short term homeless solutions; and

WHEREAS, in 2024, calls to place persons in the shelter have been met with unavailable room in the Welland location; and

WHEREAS, per the most recent Homeless by name list date from the Region, it lists that 134 persons identify Welland as their home community (which represents 11% of the total list of 1,177 persons) of this, 96 persons had been recently housed in a shelter and 21 were unsheltered and may or may not be residing in Welland and 17 persons were accommodated by friends, 54 persons were identified as chronically homeless. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLAND directs staff to partner with local groups and agencies to open and fund a temporary 8 bed shelter for the months of February and March 2024 and to allocate \$35,000 from the Operating Surplus Account in order to maximize the available days that the shelter would be open.
