LEGISLATED PUBLIC HEARINGS PURSUANT TO THE PLANNING ACT

Councillor Speck presided as Chair of the Public Hearing:

24-36 Complete applications have been made by Upper Canada Consultants on behalf of 1454417Ontario Ltd. for the lands Block 29, Plan 59M429; Subject to an easement in gross over Part 1 on 59R15949 as in SN533156, Welland. Municipally known as 44 Heron Street. The intention of these applications is to permit a street townhouse development and a mixed use apartment development with commercial and amenity spaces on the main floor and apartment units above. Application for Official Plan Amendment to redesignate part of the lands from Special Policy Medium Density Residential to High Density Residential, and application for Zoning By-law Amendment to rezone the lands from Neighbourhood Commercial – NC to Residential Medium Density Site-Specific – RM for the townhouse portion of the development and Residential High Density Site-Specific for the mixed use apartment building.

Taylor Meadows confirmed that the statutory requirements for public hearing had been met, summarized the purpose of the hearing and reviewed the Planning Division Report.
