Policy Statement:

- 1) The City will not collect:
 - a) Construction or building material of any sort, i.e. lumber, earth, broken concrete, plaster, roofing materials, fencing and fence posts, lathing, siding, shingles, etc.;
 - b) Household furniture or furnishings, i.e. Chairs, tables, tanks, mattresses, rugs, etc;
 - c) Trees and limbs removed from private property whether cut up or not (for exception see 2c below).

NOTE: For all the above materials the resident must make arrangements to take the refuse to the City disposal area themselves.

- 2) The City will collect:
 - a) Small quantities of cutting or clipping, if placed in proper container or plastic bag;
 - b) Newspapers and magazines, if securely tied in bundles;
 - c) branches or limbs, it completely trimmed, placed in tied bundles not to exceed six (6) in number, not exceeding three (3) feet in length and two (2) feet in any other dimension, and not exceeding fifty (50) lbs;
 - d) Cuttings, weeds, clippings, if placed in proper containers for collection (containers cannot exceed four (4) in number nor have a weight greater than fifty (50) lts. no loose material).

* All materials must be placed at curbside for collection and not on private property or laneways. Materials must be placed in proper containers or in tied bundles or it will not be collected.

- 3) There will be a concentrated clean-up period:
 - i) Last two (2) weeks in May; and
 - ii) Last two (2) weeks in September During these clean-up periods only, all disposable material will be collected
