FACT SHEET

What is Wellness for All?

A financial assistance program that is designed to assist those with limited financial resources to participate in programs offered by the Recreation and Culture Division. Registration fees are shared equally between the registrant, program donor and the City of Welland.

How do individuals apply for Wellness For All?

Individuals must complete a Wellness For All application form for submission to the Community Development/Volunteer Coordinator at the Welland Community Wellness Complex. The application form will be reviewed and the applicant will be contacted within 2 weeks of submission should funding be available. A follow-up interview (in-person/ZOOM) is required for all applicants who meet the outlined criteria.

Where does the money come from to fund Wellness For All?

Generous organizations from Welland donate money annually towards the Wellness For All program. This money is matched by the City of Welland directly dollar for dollar.

What kind of programs does Wellness For All fund?

Approved funding may only be used towards City of Welland recreation and culture programs. Wellness For All does not apply to the summer day camp program.

What is the cancellation policy on programs funded by Wellness For All?

If the City of Welland cancels a program due to lack of registration the applicant will have the option for a refund of the monies paid or an account credit for future use.

What is the refund policy on programs funded by Wellness For All? If a participant requests a refund for a program, monies are

What is the criteria for applying and receiving funding?

- -Interested applications must be residents of Welland. Wellness For All will **NOT** fund non-residents.
- -Applicants must demonstrate financial limitation (ie. Proof of limited resources such as an ODSP or Ontario Works statement)
- -Participants must attend at least 75% of their funded program in order to receive future funding
- -Funding must be available at the applicants age bracket in order to be considered. Funding may not always be available as it is based on donations from community organizations
