THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLAND amends the budget to include an IT Project Manager in 2025 to oversee the implementation of the IT Strategic Masterplan and management of technology and digital initiatives.

WHEREAS, the proposed budget for the Arts and Culture Awards Program is based on the funding model of the City of Welland Sports Award Night and Sports Promotion & Wall of Fame;
